





There's white... then again there's also white!

Things change with time...

When illuminated ground signals were first introduced, the lamps were low power incandescent types. UK 2-light signals used two white lamps plus one red. We have accurately reproduced the correct red tint however doing the same for the two white lamps was not so simple!

Already quite "Warm" in colour, the white lamps yellowed when they because dirty as the tar-laden air of the steam era surrounded them every day. Being a "Steam era modeller" I took this into account when we created our Mimic ground signal range.

However... these same signals still exist today, and our clients model a period which covers from the start of stem to the present day. We therefore received a little criticism for our colour choice from those who model the world after the BR blue period... or whose modelling area contains the same lamps, converted by Network rail to LED lighting.

While we do read and take note of every comment about our products, I am sure that some simply felt we did not, because changing things takes a lot of time. However... to all who responded—we DID listen and I'm delighted to advise you that we now have our 3-light ground signals available with two different "White tint" options.

- In our original and slightly yellowed "Steam Era" tint.
- In our new BR blue and beyond "Diesel Era" much whiter tint.
