The Bus Wire stripper...


Sometimes you pick up a tool and just KNOW that it is right! The DCCconcepts <u>DCT-BWS</u> wire stripper is a pleasure to hold, simple to use and very versatile.

Built to an extremely high standard, it will outlast other seemingly similar offerings and quickly become one of the most frequently used tools on your workbench.

- It has a carefully balanced lever action that multiplies the power of your grip so even the heaviest wire can be stripped with almost no effort and in no time at all. A real benefit to all, with the reduced stress on your hands especially helpful for older modellers.
- It can comfortably strip ALL weights of wire around the layout.
- It can handle all wire sizes, from the heaviest "Power Bus" wire to droppers and the finer wire often used for switch connection.
- It has an adjustable distance stop for precise stripping if needed
- It can either just strip the ends OR simply separate the insulation along the wire length so you can add droppers and branches in the wiring without cutting the power bus.
- It is also a wire cutter and a crimping tool.
- It is made from the best materials to last a lifetime.

At only £25.95 the <u>DCT-BWS</u> is a "lifetime tool" that is exceptional value for every modeller and would be a gift long remembered and a tool that will be treasured by any recipient.







The XTC Track Cutter

Used properly to cut the rail from top to bottom, it will cut nickel silver rail so cleanly that you will rarely need to clean the cut with a file before laying the track... but it can do much more.

- The perfect track cutter for OO, HO, N and other modelling scales using finer rail.
- A very sharp flat-back cutter ideal for clean cuts in alloys, brass, copper, nickel silver and similar non-ferrous metals.
- Cut plastics, wood and card easily and exceptionally cleanly.

Because of the carefully set angle of the cutting face, the cuts you make with the <u>DCT-XTC</u> track cutter are exceptionally clean and may not need any filing at all after cutting.

(By the way - when using the <u>XTC</u> cutter, always cut rail from top to bottom as this presents the thinnest metal profile for the cleanest cut, plus minimum stress on the track cutters <u>and</u> your hands) By the way...

Modelling tools can often be used for things never conceived when they were created... So either keep them hidden or buy your partner their own pair. For example we know from those we cannot identify that some modellers have really tough toenails, and the <u>DCT-XTC</u> are apparently also the cleanest and easiest to use toenail cutters ever created :-).

Whatever motivates your purchase, at £12.95, <u>DCT-XTC</u> are great value for the layout <u>and</u> workbench, and will always be a gift that is appreciated by a railway modeller.









The Perfect Christmas Idea?

The HTC Track cutter

Did you know that there are TWO kinds of track cutter?

The <u>HTC</u> is used to cut track that is already laid, and, because the cutting area is much larger when track is cut this way, it has a heavier jaw structure and slightly different cutting angle on the blade.

You should use this version for heavier rail too (anything larger than code 100)

When used properly, the <u>DCT-HTC</u> it will cut Nickel silver rail very cleanly so you will rarely need to clean the cut with a file before laying the track... but it can do much more.

- The perfect track cutter for OO, HO, N and other modelling scales where you need to cut vertically as the track is already laid <u>or</u> when using heavier rail profiles.
- A very sharp flat-back cutter ideal for clean cuts in alloys, brass, copper, nickel silver and similar non-ferrous metals.
- Will also cut plastics, wood and card easily and exceptionally cleanly.

Because of the carefully set angle of the cutting face, the cuts you make with the <u>DCT-HTC</u> track cutter are very clean and may not need any filing at all after cutting.

At £15.95, <u>DCT-HTC</u> is a tough tool that represents great value for the layout <u>and</u> workbench, and will always be a gift that is appreciated by a railway modeller.
