To best depict the absolute luxury of these coaches, it is important that those white-covered tables and lamps look just right. So what have Hornby and Bachmann produced?

Here is Hornby's Pullman Carriage with illuminated table lamps.

The lamps are a little too conical and their tables are white plastic blocks.





Here is Bachmann's Pullman Carriage with illuminated table lamps.

The table lamps look plastic and have no lampshade. Again, the tables are plain white blocks and there is no detail.

Here we see an upgraded carriage—notice the height of the table in the window, the high level of detail on the lampshades and the pool of light on the table. The colour of the light from the lamp has also been carefully matched with the prototype - giving a superb sense of realism.

Where do I get the Working Table Lamps?

The pack includes 10 tables with place settings and working table lamps. These are scored on the underside so that they can be used as a 2-seat or a 4-seat table setting.

Also in the pack is some copper tape and various resistors so you can select the brightness of the lamps in your carriage.
